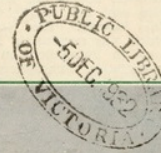

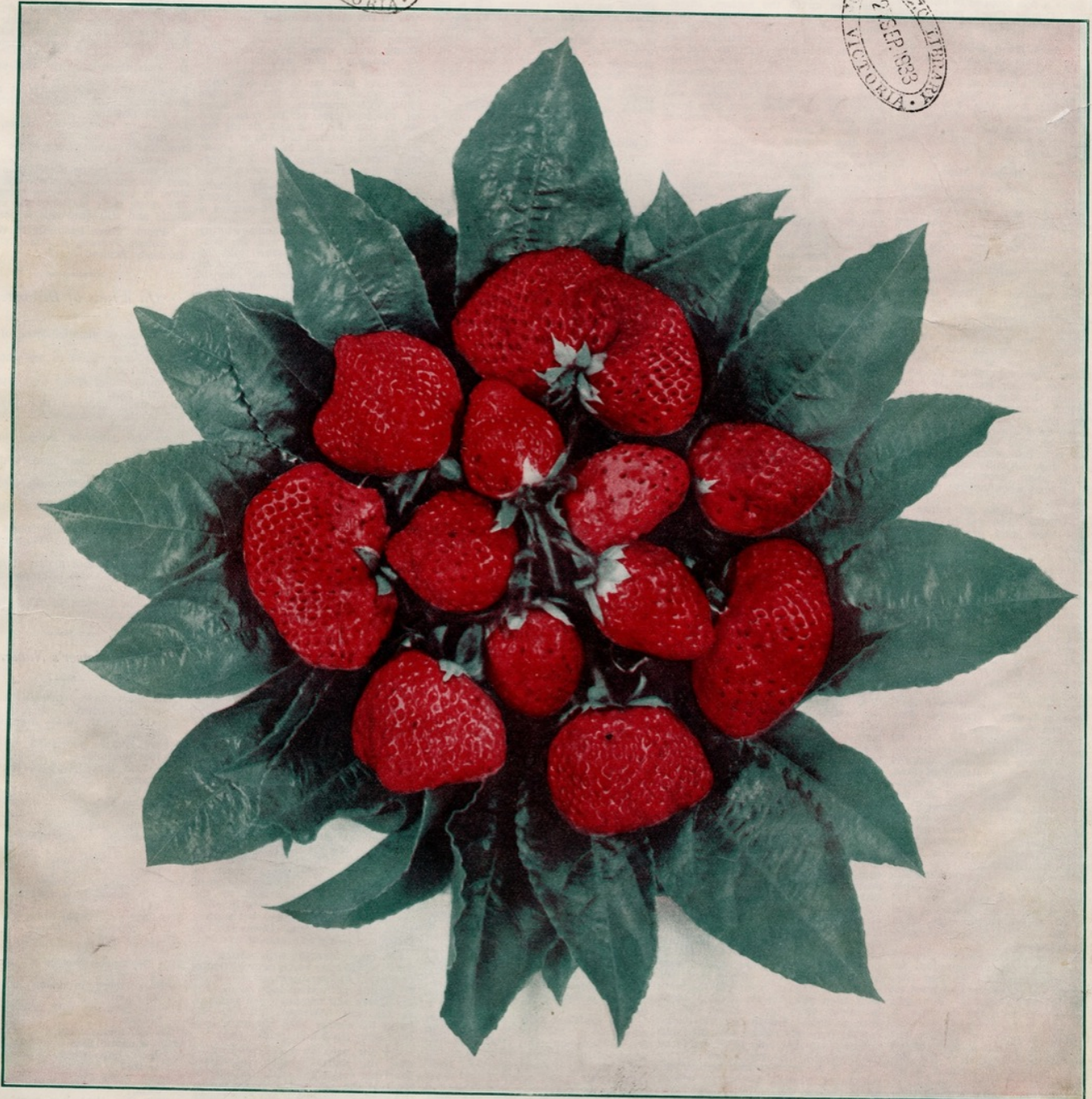

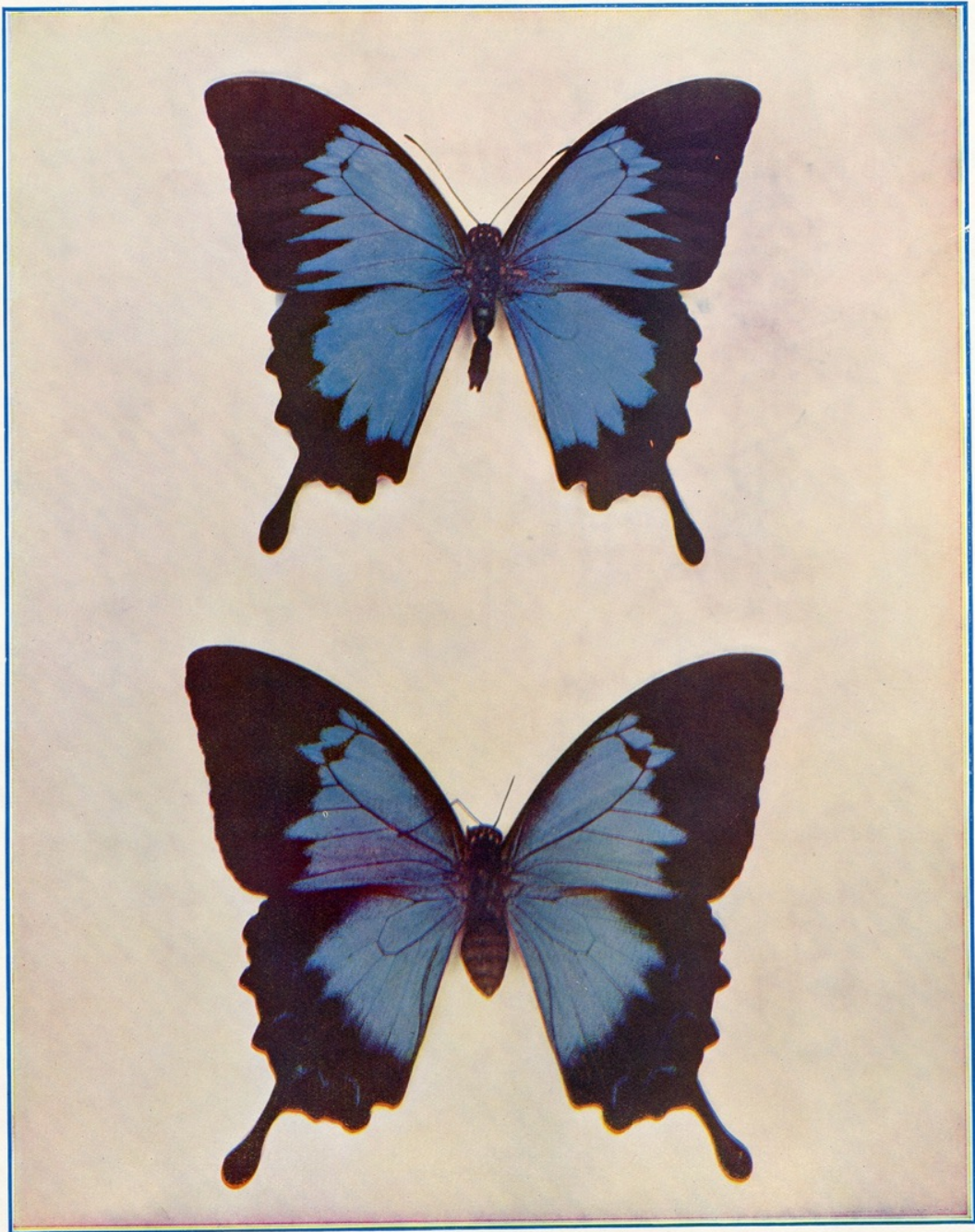

## A TEMPTING ARRAY OF QUEENSLAND STRAWBERRIES.

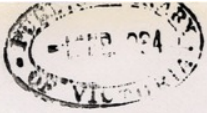
The variety illustrated, named Foreman's Federal, has an interesting history. It displays a rich, deep red colour unusual in strawberries.—See "Garden Notes."
